### County Attorney Investigator/Interdiction Special Agent

Kleberg County Attorney's Office is accepting applications for an Interdiction Special Agent and an Investigator with the Kleberg County Attorney's Criminal Interdiction Unit. Applicant must be a law enforcement officer/agent with arrest authority in the prevention, detection, apprehension, detention and/or investigation of felony and/or misdemeanor violations of federal, state, local, tribal, or military criminal laws whose primary duties include traffic enforcement; patrol and or criminal drug interdiction.

Responsible for conducting investigations relating to criminal activity including possession, trafficking, packaging, use of dangerous drugs and other specialized investigations concerning illicit diversions, manufacture, importation, and trafficking of narcotics and conduct traffic stops. The candidate must be able to cultivate confidential informants, gather tips from citizens, develop investigations, write and serve search warrants (state and federal), and work with all state, local and federal agencies. Must be pro-active and be capable of working with minimal supervision. Must be flexible and able to work variable schedules. Must have high integrity and moral turpitude and be able to deal with the public in a courteous and professional manner.

**TRAINING, EXPERIENCE AND/OR OTHER REQUIREMENTS:** TCOLE certified peace officer. Minimum one (1) year law enforcement experience. Experience on Fourth Amendment and how it relates to narcotics investigations. Must be able to qualify with firearms accepted by the standards of TCOLE.

**REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:** Knowledge of the principles, current trends, techniques and procedures of criminal investigations. Skill to operate technical equipment such as audio and video surveillance equipment. Ability to make decisions which could have critical impact on the public, department and the County. Ability to understand County policies and state/federal laws. Ability to obtain evidence and prepare detailed reports. Ability to communicate clearly and concisely with attention to detail both orally and in writing. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships and to communicate with department personnel, County employees and the public in a courteous and professional manner.

All County employees are required in the course and scope of their employment to provide services for the benefit of the general public during emergency situations that threaten the safety of Kleberg County citizens. County employees must be able to work immediately before, during, and/or immediately after an emergency.

All positions require the following: 1) High School diploma or equivalent, 2) valid driver's license, 3) satisfactory driving record and 4) proof of citizenship and/or eligibility to work in the U.S. legally, 5) Resume. The successful applicant will be required to take and pass a pre-employment physical examination, drug screen and background investigation.
