RESOLUTION 2026 -06 Board Elections
(Order of General Election)**

WHEREAS, the Ricardo Independent School District Board of Trustees has three positions which the term of office expires in November 2026; and

WHEREAS, Position 1, currently held by Carol Cannon; Position 2, currently held by Angela Bull, and Position 3, currently held by Mario Mendieta; are the positions in which the term of office expires in 2026; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED:

That a general election for Ricardo ISD Board of Trustee Positions 1, 2, and 3 be held on the 3rd day of November, 2026.

Ricardo ISD will hold the election jointly with Kleberg County. The election shall be held between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. on November 3, 2026 in Kleberg County at the following designated polling places in Kingsville, Texas:

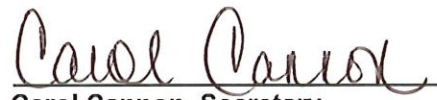

In all respects, the election shall be conducted in accordance with the Texas Election Code (the "Code"). Pursuant to the federal Help America Vote Act ("HAVA") and the Code, at each polling place there shall be at least one voting system that is equipped for disabled individuals, and each such voting system shall be a system that has been certified by the Texas Secretary of State as compliant with HAVA and the Code.
